

Group Learning Review

This session can be initiated by one instructor; candidates are then left to reflect on their own.

Environment: equipment

- Flip chart
- Pens

All candidates should be gathered in a room together. We suggest that this is a relatively informal space with coffee available to encourage discussions.

Set

The instructor writes a couple of questions onto the flip chart for the group to discuss and record once the instructor has left them. (This can be pre-prepared)

- Describe your most significant learning points from the course
- What specifically can you go away and enact immediately?
- What barriers do you envisage might prevent you making progress in your work setting?
- Does anyone have any solutions to any of these barriers?

Encourage the group to draw on the reflections they have made in their reflective logs; feedback from instructors and mentors; conversations they have had with colleagues. Leave them to proceed with the discussion.

Dialogue

The group will have a reflective discussion based around the above questions without any instructors present, while the faculty have their faculty meeting. Hopefully they will record some of their thoughts on the flipchart, although this is not essential.
